



MT STIRLING RESORT OPERATIONS - 2020

Skiing, Snowshoeing & Snowboarding

- Mt Stirling opened to snow goers on Monday 22nd June.
- Day and overnight camping trips to Mt Stirling are welcome.
- Please note all trips and resort entry must be booked in advance at: <https://shop.mtbuller.com.au/ecommerce/shop/activities/6746917/en-AU/?productsupercategoryId=13>
- While limited snow cover is currently restricting skiing and boarding, hiking and snowshoeing are encouraged.
- Please respect social distancing rules, sanitation practices and capacity limits on refuge huts and facilities, for the safety of our guests and staff.
- Due to current restrictions, refuge huts are to be used by the public for emergencies only.
- Please register via QR scanner upon arrival at Resort Entry and be sure to comprehensively fill out a Trip Intentions Form upon arrival at Telephone Box Junction. This now doubles as not only a safety protocol but also serves as a contact tracing mechanism, should there be a positive COVID-19 case detected in the Resort.

Resort Entry and Parking

There are daily capacity limits on vehicles in Resort and [pre-booking your entry and parking is essential](#). Only pre-paid bookings and permit holders will be able to enter the Resort.

Tobogganing

Current health guidelines unfortunately prevent tobogganing anywhere in the Resorts, this will be reassessed after 13 July. Snow play is permitted.
